

NRDGA Pennant Rules for 2010

Conditions of Entry to the NRDGA 2010 Pennant Series

- a/ The club must make its course available. If the course is made unavailable that club will be removed from the pennant competition.
- b/ Each host club must provide a starter and/or a referee to rule upon any disputes which might arise and to notify each team captain of this fact. The referee must collect all result sheets and fax them to the Match Committee Chairman.
Penalty for breach of condition a or b is non entry to pennant competition.
- c/ Players must conform to the dress regulations and local rules applying at the club where their game is played.
e.g. Some clubs allow metal spikes, others don't.
- d/ **Players must have a current AGU handicap or acceptable Slope handicap** Clubs must nominate their teams in handicap order.
e.g. no player in No. 3 team is to have a handicap lower than any player in the No. 2 team.

Rules

- 1/ The Match Committee of the host club shall be the sole controlling body of the pennant matches. It is the Host Club's responsibility to declare the course unplayable to the Match Committee Chairman as soon as possible.
- 2/ Motorised carts are now allowed.
- 3/ Each team captain must check the handicap of his players on the day of each pennant match.
- 4/ Play will be conducted in pairs, off the championship tees, with the No. 7 players to hit off first and then followed by the rest of the team in descending order at 7 minute intervals.
- 5/ **All matches/individual games must be finalised. The team captain should consult with the club referee to find out which hole the club would like the players to use for play offs so as not to interfere with social club competitions.**
- 6/ If a player is unable to play a replacement player may be selected to take his place but must play in the correct handicap position.
If a replacement player is used:- **The player's handicap must not break the division's lower handicap limit.**
- 7/ Team handicap limits will apply from the time of nomination and if a player breaks his handicap during the Pennants period, (from the time of nomination onwards), this will have no effect on the handicap of his team, ***(as long as a substitute player is not used)***, but can have an effect on the player's position in his team.
If a replacement player is used the team total is calculated on all players current playing handicap.
- 8/ A player, already selected in a team, may be used as a replacement in a higher or equal Division only. e.g. a Division 2 player may be used as a replacement for Division 1 or Division 2 but not Division 3, for one game only, and is entitled to return to his original team for the next game.
Penalty for a breach of rule 6, 7 or 8 is loss of match for the offending player.
- 9/ The team captain must submit his team to the starter, from 7 to 1, stating current handicaps in descending handicap order, 10 minutes before the first player is due to hit off. ***After the team is submitted it is not allowed to be changed.***
- 10/ The pennant series will be conducted as a Match Play competition. Each team in each division will play all the other teams and the top two clubs in each division will move into the final. Division 14 shall play a stroke play competition with all 7 nett scores to count.
In the event of a tie the section winner shall be decided on the aggregate of the margins of the team wins. If there is still a tie the section winner shall be decided on the aggregate of the margins of the individual wins. e.g. if player A wins 5/4 his team receives 5 points.
- 11/ If a player is late his opponent will wait for him and they will play at the end of the field. If the player has not reported by the time the last player has left the tee then he shall forfeit the game. ***If the whole team is late then it shall forfeit the match.***
- 12/ ***At the conclusion of the match the two captains must fill out the result sheet, sign it and hand it to the host referee.***
- 13/ To be eligible to play in the final a player must have played at least one game prior to the finals and must fulfil the requirements of the previous rules.
- 14/ If a team from a club fails to turn up with 7 players the club will be asked to show just cause as to why it shouldn't be disciplined. If the whole team fails to turn up the club will be asked to show cause why it should play in the next year's competition.
- 15/ ***Any practice on the course, except for designated practice areas, must be played with a maximum of two balls in use at a time, (if allowed by the host club.)***
- 16/ The Match Committee Chairman will collate the results and fax a full result sheet to each club captain the following week. Results will also be posted on the NRDGA website. (nrdga.com.au) Any protests must be received before the next game.
- 17/ **Wet Weather**
 - a) If one day of pennants is washed out the clubs involved will receive half points each for that day.
 - b) If two days of pennants are washed out; the first day's results will be halved, the second day's play will be shifted to the date set for the pennant finals and another date will be found for the finals.
 - c) If all three days are washed out the pennant series will be played as an Eisenhower Cup type tournament at a date to be fixed.
- 18/ **Handicap Lower Limits**
